The Cache Valley Historical Society will award two \$1,000 scholarships, for use in the 2024-2025 school year. Applications are due by **October 6, 2024.** Awards may go to either undergraduate or graduate students who are involved in a faculty-supervised project focused on Cache Valley History. The project may be a research paper, thesis, archival collection, exhibit, or similar project. We define Cache Valley history broadly as seen through folklore, anthropology, archaeology, businesses, agriculture, arts, education, religious, social, agriculture, engineering, or other related fields. Projects should be new proposals, but consideration will be given to projects already in progress. The project need not be limited to Cache Valley and may include surrounding areas, the entire state of Utah, and southern Idaho, provided a connection to Cache Valley is included. Applicants must have a faculty member supervising the project. **Winning applicants should be prepared to present their project to the Society at our regular meeting on April 9, 2025 at 7:00 pm in Logan, Utah.**

Applications must contain the following information in the same order as shown:

- Date of application
- Name of nominee or applicant
- Applicant mailing address
- Email address
- Phone number
- Current status (e.g. senior, graduate student, etc.)
- Major
- Faculty supervisor/ University address / e-mail / phone number
- Description of proposed project
- What will the end product be (e.g., paper, thesis, musical composition, historical drama, exhibit, etc.)?
- How will the project increase knowledge and/or awareness of Cache Valley history?
- Information that indicates your qualifications (e.g., interest in subject, previous experience, any previous related work, etc.).
- Biographical information that applicant or nominator thinks might be helpful to the selection committee.
